Moreover, our strengths to initiate cooperation with other societies are going ahead: Brian Moss, the President of SIL, as well as some Vice-presidents will attend our SEFS in Münster. In addition, our colleagues from SFS (Society for Freshwater Science, ex NABS) will also join us at SEFS. I invite you to submit your comments and/or suggestions to further increase the visibility of our Federation.
